1. Background

The Refugee Solidarity Network (RSN) is a U.S.-based, tax-exempt, non-profit organization with the mission to protect and expand the rights of refugees. In partnership with advocates and local stakeholders, RSN builds the capacity of local legal actors in key host countries, advocates for rights-based refugee assistance policies and programs, and raises awareness of the refugee experience. Our work comes at the intersection of international humanitarian assistance, migration, and international development.

RSN is undertaking research to clarify and strengthen compliance with international humanitarian guidelines.

2. Purpose of the Consultancy

The primary objective of the assignment is to provide high-level, research-based guidance to inform RSN's future engagement of external stakeholders and service participants.

3. Scope of Consultancy

The Consulting Services to be provided by Consultant shall include, but not be limited to, the following services:

A. Research the SPHERE standards and other humanitarian services standards and guidelines for guidance on best practices in handling certain sensitive situations where beneficiaries are involved. Specific scenarios to be presented may include beneficiaries known to have perpetrated or been involved in criminal offenses in their country of origin or host country. Circumstances to be further considered include situations with children or minor beneficiaries and beneficiaries that are unwillingly transacting with terrorist groups (formally designated and not formally designated) to protect family members.

- B. Output: Through your research, formulate a memo outlining your findings and outline those findings and a draft policy for service-providers on how to handle sensitive situations in a presentation to be delivered at the conclusion of the consultancy.
